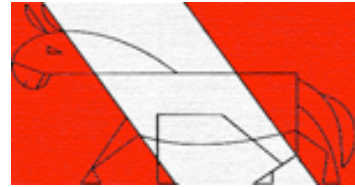

PADI Rescue Diver

The PADI Rescue Diver course develops your diving knowledge and skills to enable you to effectively perform diver assists and rescues, manage diving accident situations and render first aid in a diving situation. It is also the best fun you will have in a wet suit!

The programme is an important step in expanding your knowledge and experience as a diver and is a hugely rewarding programme.

You will cover knowledge development and confined water exercises, we will then move on to open water, where you combine all the skills and knowledge gained into a number of simulated dive accident scenarios.

And when you have completed your Rescue Diver course, remember, you are just one step away from your first PADI professional qualification, the Divemaster. Or, if you are not interested in a professional qualification and you have five speciality certifications, you can apply for your Master Scuba Diver rating.

If you do not have a current first aid certificate, we can offer the Emergency First Response course prior to commencing the Rescue Diver course.

Price includes tuition, the course manual and certification fee. Equipment hire is available.

Course Prerequisites

- Minimum age: 12 years.
- PADI Advanced Open Water Diver or equivalent.
- Certificate of first aid and CPR completed within 2 years of the course start date.
- If you are not a PADI diver and you are enrolling onto the Rescue Diver course you will need a minimum of 20 logged dives.

Fitness Requirements

To participate in this PADI course you must complete the [PADI Medical Questionnaire](#). (link to .pdf) If you answer 'YES' to any question you would need to visit your GP or a doctor specialising in diving medicine to obtain medical clearance to dive.
